Savor Hospitality Cooking School Agreement

This Cooking School Agreement is dated _____, 2007, between Savor Hospitality, Inc., "Savor Hospitality", and _____, "Guest", for the _____ Class, the "Class".

Savor Hospitality desires to offer cooking instruction classes in exchange for payment by Guest according to the following terms, conditions and obligations:

1. Participation in Savor Hospitality Cooking School Classes may involve students using cooking equipment and utensils in a live kitchen environment. Please be aware that the kitchen can be a dangerous place with sharp objects, boiling liquids and scalding pots and pans. Please be aware of your surroundings at all times. Classes may involve students handling raw food products and food products that may cause allergic reactions. Classes may also involve the service of wine and alcoholic beverages. All laws related to Alcoholic Beverage Control apply. No alcohol shall be served to any person under the age of 21. It is understood that by making payment for and by participating in a class, the student releases, indemnifies and hold harmless Savor Hospitality, Inc., the chef, owner, and employees for any and all liability of any kind of damages and/or injuries incurred in connection with student attendance at a cooking class.
2. It is expressly recommended that class participants wear rubber-soled, non-slip shoes. Long hair should be restrained. No loose jewelry, dangling earrings, bracelets or necklaces should be worn while operating kitchen equipment. Participants should be aware of surroundings at all times.
3. Vigorous hand washing with warm water and soap is required after using the bathroom, sneezing, coughing or handling raw food products. Hand washing is the single most important activity that can be done to prevent most food-borne illnesses. Be safe, protect others.
4. The client is liable for any damage to equipment or utensils, normal wear and use excepted.
5. Children attending classes are the responsibility of the parent. No one under 10 years of age is permitted. Children may be excused from class for unruly behavior without a refund.
6. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
7. Savor Hospitality reserves the right to cancel classes and provide a full refund when class minimums are not met.
